Colliding Golf Balls - Scenario 2

When one ball is played from off the green and one from on the green and they collide when they are in motion, the ball played from off the green should be played as it lies for the next shot. There is no penalty and if the ball is deflected into the hole it is deemed to be holed. However, the ball that is played from on the putting green must be replayed from the previous spot, there is no penalty and the original stroke does not count. A deflection into hole still results in a replay, i.e. the ball has not been holed.
